

Knit or Crochet Camp for Kids!

Greetings from the Knitters and Crocheters at Bishop Cummins! We are excited to be running a summer camp to teach kids ages 9+ how to knit or crochet, July 11-15, from 9am – 12noon.

Last year we only offered simple knitting. This year students can choose to learn to knit or to crochet. Knitting uses two needles while crocheting uses a 5 ½ inch hook.

Each day will have sessions for learning and practicing the stitches as well as a snack and a short time to play outside. If you choose to knit, your project will be a washcloth made from colorful cotton. If you choose to crochet, you will make a potholder. We may even have some time to learn to finger knit 😊!

At the end of the week, you will get to keep your needles or hook and your yarn as well as your project.
